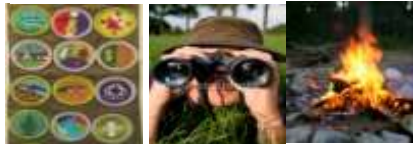

The 2012 year brings the 100th anniversary of the first Eagle Scout medal. The National Council will provide a special award to scouts who attain the rank of Eagle this year. It is also the 100th Anniversary of our Council.

If you are a Life Scout looking to start your Eagle Project, there is a new Eagle Service Project Workbook that has been published and must be used as of January 1, 2012. This new form should make the project approval occur sooner and allow

scouts to begin the final planning and work on the projects.

ANNUAL RE-CHARTERING

Every year our Troop completes the re-charter process which involves each and every one of us. We need to have our paperwork completed before the end of January 2012. We will be sending out a short letter in the mail near the end of this month explaining the process. The fee for re-charter for the 2012 calendar year is \$37 per scout. We will also need to review our

Service project and camping history for the year to apply for special awards for individuals and the troop available through the National council. The fee

for re-charter can be paid at the scout meetings.
