

Uniform Policy

The following is the uniform policy for Troop 167:

1. Class-A Uniform:

The required Class A uniform for Troop 167 is the official Boy Scout shirt with Troop 167 numbers and council patches, a Scout neckerchief (or one designated for the occasion) and slide. For meetings and campouts, the scouts may wear blue jeans, Scout trousers, or Scout shorts with Scout socks. For Court of Honors and special occasions, athletic shoes and sandals are unacceptable; the shoes for special occasions should be black or brown shoes or hiking boots. The scout may at anytime, wear the official Scout trousers or Scout shorts with Scout socks. If a hat is worn with this uniform, it will be a Scout hat or Troop hat and will be worn outdoors and while traveling, and not indoors.

2. Class-B Uniform:

Class-B uniform includes a "Scout T-shirt" which includes a Troop 167 shirt for those scouts that have them, a summer camp shirt or other scout shirt. On some occasions, the Troop may select a special shirt that will easily identify our group during outings. The boy may wear either blue jeans, Scout trousers, or Scout shorts with Scout socks.

The above policy also applies to the Scoutmaster and all Assistant Scoutmasters and is optional for all other Troop Committee positions.

Exceptions to the above policy: Eagle Scouts and adults may wear any of the optional Scout bolo ties. Wood Badge beads are acceptable neckwear for the adults who have earned them.

The following are the guidelines for wearing the above uniforms:

1. The Class-A uniform is to be worn at Troop Meetings, when the troop leaves and returns from outings, at Courts of Honors, Boards of Reviews and as requested by the Scoutmaster.
2. The Class-B uniform will be worn when the troop is on an outing or at summer camp when the Class A uniform is not required. Class B uniform may be worn in the summer months if allowed by the Scoutmaster.
